

Public Comment at Board Meetings

Members of the public are invited to address the board during Open Meetings on any topic related to library business. Those wishing to speak must sign the Public Comment sheet before the meeting identifying themselves by name, town, and organization (if applicable); this information will be recorded in the Minutes of the meeting. Speakers should limit their comments to 5 minutes or less. The Board will not enter into two-way conversation with members of the public. Trustees will take public comments under advisement. Trustees wishing to ask clarifying questions will be recognized by the president before speaking.
