Youth and adult kits are available on the first of each month. Supplies are limited.




Don't forget about our ongoing youth programs! **1000 Books Before Kindergarten** runs year-round & Brag Tags runs Labor Day through Memorial Day.

# **Community Holiday Caroling** Friday 12/2 • 5 p.m.




Join us for caroling, hot cocoa, cookies, and crafts! This annual family event is generously supported by FRGMS and the District 3 PTO.




# Family Storytime (all ages)
