- Access via the Kanopy app, a smart TV, or a desktop at frgml.kanopy.com
- FRGML adult cardholders can register using their library card number and email
- Registered users get 25 tickets per month on the first of the month (no rollovers)
- Number of tickets per video is generally set by runtime, ranging from 0-5 tickets each
- Viewing periods range from 2-7 days
- Kanopy Kids content requires no tickets and has unlimited viewing
