



## Non-Resident Library Cards

Non-residents who do not live within any other public library taxing district are required to pay a fee for the use of the Library for one year.

The non-resident fee for property owners shall be calculated by multiplying the evaluation figure from the patron's property tax bill by the tax rate for the current year (see below). Rates change annually.

The non-resident fee for renters shall be calculated as 15% of one month's rent, as demonstrated by proof of lease agreement.

Library cards will be issued to all eligible members within the household upon registration including payment of the non-resident fee, and account benefits will expire annually, one year from the date of registration. Non-resident cards allow participation in all Fox River Grove Memorial Library programs and services equal to Fox River Grove district resident cardholders.

## Tax Year 2025 Fees (collection starts in 2026)

The Library Tax Rate for Tax Year 2025 is:

0.382768

To calculate a non-resident fee, multiply the Net Taxable Amount from the patron's property tax bill by
